



## JAMES KAZAKOS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Board of Directors of the Orange County Family Justice Center Foundation (OCFJCF) established the James Kazakos Scholarship Fund in November 2016.

The mission of the Fund is to allow the Orange County Family Justice Center Foundation to assist graduates of the Foundation's programs to pursue a college-level (including trade school) education and use that education to empower themselves and their families, breaking the cycle of family violence.

### **SELECTION OF AWARDEES**

Receiving a scholarship from the Fund requires three steps:

#### **1. Completion of Application.**

The applicant for the scholarship will submit a written application approved by the Board, along with a resume. The intent of this requirement is to strengthen resume-writing skills, develop leadership abilities, and encourage identification of personal goals. Applications will be evaluated based on five categories: Personal, Accomplishments, Goals, Community Impact and Extras. #### **2. Review by Scholarship Committee.**

The Board of Directors will establish a scholarship award committee. The committee will comprise at least one member of the Board of Directors, one of whom is either the Vice President or President-Elect. At least two other people (for a total of three) will be committee members. The two-committee members do not have to be on the Board of Directors, but should be familiar with the Foundation and its mission and programs. The committee will review all completed application packages. It is the intent of the Board that the committee review completed applications in January, to allow time to announce awards in March 2022, prior to most schools' financial aid deadlines.

#### **3. Selection of Awardees**

The committee will select scholarship candidates for recommendation to the Board of Directors. The committee can recommend any number and size of awards as funds support. The Board of Directors will

vote to approve the allocation of money from the James Kazakos Scholarship fund to the recipients based on the scholarship committee's recommendation.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPLY**

1. Must be an Orange County resident
2. Must be entering a 2-4 year or vocational college or university
3. Must have participated in one of the OC Family Justice Center Foundation programs (e.g., Target Back to School event, Adopt-A-Family, Real Teens Real Talk, Motown Dance, Teen Ambassadors, Sight and Sketches Art class) **within the last 2 years**
4. Submit a resume
